

## **Slovak – Mexican Cooperation Road Transport Safety – BECEP 2024**

The 18th edition of the Road Transport Safety Conference – BECEP 2024 was attended in person by an invited guest from Mexico, Mr. Gerardo José Yánez Porcayo. The branch of the Slovak Road Association at the Slovak Road Administration, together with a representative of the Ministry of Transport of the Slovak Republic and in cooperation with other members of the preparatory committee, prepared a technical excursion for the guest. The programme of the excursion consisted of a site visit and a tour of the Regional Management and Maintenance Centre of the National Motorway Company (Národná diaľničná spoločnosť, a.s. / NDS) in Bratislava and the Management and Maintenance Centre of the Bratislava D4/R7 bypass. The staff of NDS presented in detail the Central Operator's Workplace of the Sitina tunnel and both centres presented in detail all the mechanisms used to maintain road traffic safety and smooth traffic flow on the operated sections of the road network. The concessionaire of the Bratislava bypass presented the central control room of the managed section. The D4/R7 project encompasses the construction of a 27km motorway section (D4) between the municipalities of Jarovce and Rača and a 32 km expressway section (R7) between Prievoz and Holice. Subsequently, the guest was taken for a drive to see the above mentioned section and the Sitina tunnel in person.
